CSFOA board meeting to interview and determine the assignor position for the 2013 season. It was called to order at 6:30 by Craig Cox.

The meeting was attended by Craig Cox, Rex Watson, George Demetriou, Dennis Wansor, DJ Bremser, Ray Lutz and Doug Fosdick and the names mentioned below. Mark Bradley and David Allgood were not present.

Candidates were: Mike DeSanto, Clyde Thomas, Mark Mitchell, Mark VanGambleare, Mike Quintana and Rich Gray. All the candidates were present except Mike DeSanto. Each had the opportunity to explain why they were applying for the position.


During the interview process, the rate of pay issue came up. Craig Cox has stated that after his conversations with a number of AD's, the rate at which the schools are going to pay the assignor has not been set but will likely be lower than in the past. Craig is thinking the rate per school is going to run in the \$45 range down from \$75.

After the candidates were finished with their presentations, the board (minus Mark VG and Rich Gray) voted that Rich Gray be the 2013 assignor. The vote was as follows: Cox, Bradley (by proxy), Fosdick, Demetriou, Bremser and Watson for Gray. Lutz and Wansor for VanGambleare.

Following the vote there was discussion on how much of the association dues money should go to the assignor. Currently the amount \$17 of the \$25 total is paid for assigning. A motion was made by George Demetriou to have none of the dues money go to the assignor where it was seconded by Doug Fosdick. The vote failed by a count of 3 yes and 4 no.

Another motion was brought by George Demetriou that only \$5 dollars of the dues money go to the assignor where it was seconded by Doug Fosdick. It passed by a count of 4 yes 3 no.
